### June meeting minutes

Accepted with minor correction (Santa Fe City working with for runner friendly city not Santa Fe County)

### Treasurers report

- Striders' balance: \$27,522
  - +2,764 on year. This includes unrealized items and excludes the Scholarship Fund which is pledged over ten years.
- Run Around net-before-donation to GOTR is \$2,634. This includes a +5,000 pledge from SECU and \$900 paid to Phoenix Security which was not part of previous estimate. GOTR donation to be decided.
- Running Festival financials are not yet finalized but will likely will net approximately \$5500.
- We have placed \$15,000 into a Vanguard money market account to earn extra interest.

### **Financial Discussion**

- Without running festival we would be at a significant deficit for the year.
- Dues alone are a deficit: does not cover RRCA and track rental
- Do we need to raise membership price in the future? Or we can keep relying on races to make up the difference
- Something to keep an eye on in the future
